The December Board of Directors meeting will take place on the 21st of December at 7pm in the lounge of the clubhouse. All members are welcome to attend. The lounge is set up in a way that social distancing can be achieved.

As previously mentioned, The Board of Directors has approved Premier Landscape Services to handle the task of snow removal this winter. This will be Premier's second year plowing for us. Please take time to read the snow removal guidelines. Please remember, if you have a vehicle parked in your driveway and the bobcat operator does not feel he can plow next to the vehicle, they will pass over that driveway until the vehicle is moved. The last thing we want to see is the plow hitting a vehicle in the driveway. Please also remember, if you have landscaping lights or decorations along walkways or driveways, please remove them before the snow flies. The crews cannot see these lights and decorations and normally if not moved, they are damaged.

Mike Grilli and the Finance Committee are working on the Budget for the upcoming year. All planned maintenance projects are included in the budget along with some needed upgrades to the clubhouse. Once the budget is approved, copies will be available at the clubhouse.

Trash cans continue to be an ongoing problem around Westlake. Cans are not to be put out at the street until 5pm the night before pickup. The cans must be put back in the garage the day of pickup. The trash cans are not to be stored in front or behind the garage. They must be kept in the garage. Violations are being issued for those not in compliance. Also, we have heard many reports of mice in garages. Please take the time to make sure that you do not have any food stored in the garage. Even a small amount of food will attract mice.

Just a reminder this is the time of year to have your furnace serviced. Also make sure smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors are present within the home and are working properly. Make sure to change batteries in these devices if you have not already. Also, make sure your outside hoses are disconnected and drained.

We continue to take donations for those in need at the clubhouse. If you are able, please drop off any non-perishable items in the blue bin located in the game room of the clubhouse.

Snow Removal 2022/2023

Please review the following snow removal guidelines.

The snow removal contract calls for plowing, clearing of driveways, walks and front stoops after a two inch snow fall. *Please note we do not clear private patios or decks.*

Any snow fall resulting in an accumulation of less than two inches will be the responsibility of the homeowner to remove if so desired.

The Association does not provide, not authorize the contractor to apply salt or any type of de-icer. Again, this will be up to each individual homeowner.

After the association has completed snow removal on the streets, the Village of Bloomingdale will salt the streets according to their standards.

The clubhouse parking lot and offsite parking areas are some of the first to be cleared. Please move vehicles to these areas after they are plowed to allow for driveways to be completed safely.

The clearing of driveways is a time consuming operation and with 501 units it is obvious that not everyone can be done first. If for some reason your driveway is missed and the rest of the block is complete and no cars were in your driveway, please call the office and leave your name and address so we can direct crews accordingly. The same applies for the walk crews. If your walkway or stoop was missed, please let us know.

Please note that if the snow removal contractor does not feel comfortable plowing a portion of a driveway that has a vehicle in it, they have the right to wait until the vehicle is moved out of the driveway to complete snow removal operations.

When calling the clubhouse, please make sure to leave your address. We often have messages, but we do not have an address.

If you have lawn ornaments or lighting along the edge of your driveway or walkway, please make sure you remove these items. The crews cannot see these many times and they end up damaged.

Finally, please be patient. The Manager, The Board of Directors and the Contractor work hand in hand during a snow removal event. If you need to call and report and area that has been missed, please do so in a kind and courteous way. The office staff will note your call and alert the contractor to the area that needs service. Yelling at the office staff will not get your snow removed and faster.
